



Enjoy New Non-Stop Flight, Safari Experience in Kenya

In time for Kenya Airways' first non-stop flight between New York (JFK) and Nairobi (NBO), beginning in October, [Classic Escapes](#) introduces its 12-Day Kenya: The Original Safari Destination experience.

The itinerary follows in the footsteps of vintage safaris and features encounters with all the classic safari animals, including lions, elephants, hippos, zebras and giraffes. Guests also get the chance to meet locals and environmentalists protecting the region's wildlife and culture.

A guaranteed departure date of Nov. 1-11, 2018, is set, though additional departure dates are available upon request. More departures for 2019 are upcoming.

The itinerary includes stops in Nairobi at Samburur Reserve, Buffalo Springs Reserve, Ol Pejeta Conservancy, Lake Nakuru National Park and the Maasai Mara. Highlights include the Daphne Sheldrick Elephant Orphanage; the Karen Blixen House, home of the *Out of Africa* author; the African Fund for Endangered Wildlife Nature Center; and the Jane Goodall Institute chimpanzee sanctuary.

The trip begins at \$4,295 per person and includes luxury accommodations, all meals specified on the itinerary, airport transfer and emergency evacuation insurance.
