For years, **CroisiEurope** has delighted its guests with holiday cruises to some of Europe's most festive locations, including Paris, Venice, Bordeaux, and Nuremberg—home of the largest and most popular Christmas Market on the continent. Now, for the 2017 holiday season, CroisiEurope is adding new itineraries and making changes to its classic trips to continue its tradition of cruising for the holidays.

Christmas cruises through the Alsace region of France and the Black Forest of Germany will now stop at the Freiburg Christmas Market in Germany. There, guests can admire locally made Black Forest crafts like blown glass, colorful wooden toys, ginger cake, and mulled wine. The cruise will then continue on to Colmar in the Alsace area, where they can visit museums for a showcase of Alsatian Christmas traditions. This 4-day cruise departs Strasbourg on Nov. 28 and Dec. 4 with prices starting at \$771 pp dbl.

Also new this year is the cruise line's Christmas cruise through Provence and the Rhone Valley of France. With this itinerary, the slightly warmer winter weather of southern France is paired with stops in the charming towns of Viviers, Montelimar and Avignon on this cruise, which sails roundtrip from Lyon departing on Dec. 21 and returning on the 25th. Prices for this sailing start at \$1,409 pp dbl.
