CroisiEurope creates new PetiteSeine cruise

CroisiEurope added a new canal barge itinerary to its lineup, a six-day sailing from Paris that travels along the Petite-Seine River, a tributary of France's well-known Seine.

The itinerary includes stops in the outskirts of Paris in the neighborhoods of Evry, Melun and Saint Mammes, as well as the opportunity to explore Paris itself. There will also be excursions to the chateaus Fontainebleau and Vaux-le-Vicomte, an outing in the medieval town of Troyes, and a champagne tasting in France's Champagne region.

Prices start at \$3,175 per person and include meals served onboard, drinks from the bar, excursions, travel insurance and port fees. The departure dates for this itinerary are Oct. 6, 13, 20 and 27, 2018. The itinerary will also be available in September and October 2019.
