CroisiEurope Debuts New and Renovated Ships

CroisiEurope continues to grow and enhance its fleet, with the debut of the MS Elbe Princess II and the re-entry of the MS Van Gogh and MS Renoir into service in the aftermath of sweeping renovations to their public areas and cabins. In all, the line boasts 55 vessels in its fleet.

The 86-passenger MS Elbe Princesse II, a sister ship to the MS Elbe Princesse, will operate on itineraries between Berlin and Prague on the Elbe and Vltava rivers.

The 105-passenger MS Van Gogh will sail on Rhone and Saone river itineraries out of Lyon. The MS Renoir, which also accommodates 105 guests, will operate on Seine River cruises sailing between Paris and Honfleur.

The line's fleet expansion continues beyond this year. In 2019, the company said it plans to construct the MS Amalia Rodrigues, which will become the sixth ship in the line's fleet to operate on itineraries plying Portugal's Douro River.

In early 2017, the 132-passenger MS Miguel Torga became the fifth Croisi vessel in the Douro River fleet. Additionally, the 110-passenger MS Symphonie II and France Douce II inaugurated service on the Danube and Rhine rivers last year.

In other developments, CroisiEurope said it will waive single supplement fees for all 2019 departures on bookings made before June 30, 2018.
