The next three days will be spent at Sosian Ranch, a beautiful restored house set within 24,000 acres of working ranch on the Laikipia plateau. At this unique property Samburu herdsman guard their cattle among the wildlife, creating scenes reminiscent of 19th century Africa. Guests are welcome to learn about ranch life in the wild between exciting game drives. Adventurous experiences include horseback riding through the game filled ranch, camel safaris and swimming in the spectacular waterfalls along the Euaso Narok River.

The safari ends at the Off Beat Mara tented camp in the Greater Maasai Mara, known as the quintessential game park. This intimate camp sleeps 12 guests in traditional safari tents and is tucked into a hidden corner of a private conservancy just outside the main park, providing guests with an exclusive environment in which to experience the animals. At this private camp, guests can get up close and personal with wildebeests, visit the rhino sanctuary and enjoy hot air balloon safari rides.
