Safari package includes time with Maasai people

Adventure travelers still have time to hop on a six-night Extraordinary Journeys Africa trip to Kenya, set to run Oct. 10 to 16. The program combines a two-day community-exchange program with a remote Maasai community, followed by a luxury safari adventure.

The first two days of the program, offered in partnership with the founder and project director of the Under the Acacia organization, will take place in the remote area of the Loita hills, where participants can interact with community members. The next four nights are spent on a wildlife safari in the Masai Mara.

The program is priced \$6,000 per person, down \$1,200 from the regular rate.
