The Taktsang Monastery in Bhutan.

WESTPORT, Conn. — Geringer Global Travel is offering a customizable 10-night itinerary through Bhutan with departures available through the year.

The plan, A Cultural Journey through Western Bhutan, is priced from \$2,460 per person, double. The cost covers hotel accommodations; all meals; sightseeing and entrance fees; the services of an English-speaking guide; private transfers; and visa and permit fees.

A sample itinerary begins in Thimphu, Bhutan's capital, where guests will see a cultural program of traditional folk songs and dance. Stops along the journey may include Taktsang Monastery, built near caves where Guru Padasambhava is said to have meditated for three months in the eighth century; Chimi Lhakhang, the temple of the divine mad monk, one of Bhutan's favorite saints; and Trongsa Dzong, the ancestral home of the Bhutan Royal Family.
