Then it's on to the jungle. Tigers, leopards, boar, sloths, multitudes of birds and other animals are viewed at Ranthambhore, Bandhavgarh and Kanha national parks via elephant rides and Jeep safaris. The trip also visits a Project Tiger reserve, which protects habitat for the big cats, before returning via plane to Delhi.
