A Hotel with a History

A Local Escape

The town's slogan is "Peaceful Pondicherry." This certainly resonates with what Pondicherry and its surrounding areas offer visitors - an eclectic mix of cultures and world philosophies. It is often referred to as the "French Riviera of the East," partly because of the fact that it remained a French colony until 1954, long after India gained political freedom.

Pondicherry is a quiet (by Indian standards), well-known beach town located in the southeastern part of the country. Its history spans centuries - possibly as far back as the second century - but, one of Pondicherry's more modern claims to fame is that it was the setting for the bestselling book, "The Life of Pi." Fans of Roald Dahl's famous children's book, "Charlie and the Chocolate Factory," might also recall that Prince Pondicherry requested that Willie Wonka build a chocolate palace in India, which subsequently melted in the hot sun.

Visitors to the area will marvel at the beautiful colonial buildings, churches and statues throughout the region, and beaches are another of Pondicherry's main attractions. Noteworthy sights include Mahatma Ghandi's statue on the Beach Promenade, the Sacred Heart Jesus Church and the Sri Manakula Vinayagar Temple.

Another draw in the area is the Sri Aurobindo Ashram, a well-known ashram in India. Devotees from India and all over the world flock

here for spiritual salvation - and as expected - during my visit, there was a substantial line at the entrance. The ashram's spiritual foundations are a blend of yoga and modern science that were founded in 1926 by Sri Aurobindo Ghose, an Indian freedom fighter, poet, philosopher and yogi. Guests can tour the main building of the temple freely during visiting hours, but those who would like to participate in meditations and dining rituals will need a special pass, which can be obtained by contacting the ashram. Private tours can also be arranged.

Not far away is the Sri Manakula Vinayagar Temple. The temple was in existence before the French settled in Pondicherry and welcomes visitors who can provide donations to the temple elephant, a favorite activity for many.

A stop at Auroville is also a good suggestion for visitors with some extra time and an open mind. The experimental township is a short drive northwest of Pondicherry off the East Coast Road. The township was founded by Mirra Richard, who is known as "The Mother" and who was also the spiritual collaborator of Sri Aurobindo. Auroville is meant to be a universal town where men and women of all countries are able to live in peace and progressive harmony, above all creeds, all politics and all nationalities. The township was designed by French architect, Roger Anger, and the community is devoted to the realization of human unity. In the middle of the town resides the Matrimandir, a symbol of what residents believe to be the "Universal Mother."

Although originally intended to house 50,000 people, the actual population is, currently, around 2,000 adults and minors who come from 44 different nations, approximately 830 of whom are of Indian origin. The community is divided into neighborhoods with English, Sanskrit, French and Tamil names such as Aspiration, Arati, La Ferme and Isaiambalam. Residents are involved in agriculture, administration, commerce, handicrafts, alternative technology, education, healthcare and development projects that include AuroRE Systems, an international, award-winning unit that is involved in solar photovoltaic and thermal systems.

Arriving in Pondicherry is relatively easy. The city is located about 100 miles from Chennai and is easily reachable by car, taxi or rail service. Diwali

Diwali, or Deepavali, one of the best-known Hindu festivals, is celebrated 18 days after Dusshera on Nov. 13. The event is called the festival of lights, and every house is illuminated with lamps and lights. The worship of Lakshmi, the goddess of wealth, is an important feature of the celebrations. Homes are spring-cleaned and decorated and the celebration is accompanied by the exchange of sweets and the explosion of fireworks. Multicolored rangoli designs and floral decorations adorn the entrance of most homes. (Nov. 13-17)


Lucknow Festival, Uttar Pradesh

This festival is celebrated between Nov. 25 and Dec. 5 and captures the elegance and splendors of the ancient city of Awadh, now known as Lucknow. Colorful processions, traditional dramas, Kathak dances in the style of the famous Lucknow Gharana, Sarangi and sitar recitals along with ghazals, qawalis and thumri create a festive atmosphere. Exciting events such as ekka races, kite flying, cock fighting and other traditional village games recreate an atmosphere of bygone Nawabi days. Cuisine and craft festivals are also organized. Chennai Dance & Music Festival, Tamil Nadu
