### Geringer Global Travel Offers Tour of India's Wildlife Sanctuaries

Geringer Global Travel is offering a wildlife journey to India called The Call of the Wild India Tour, which will explore national parks and wildlife sanctuaries in Ranthambhore, Bandhavgarh and Kanha. Accompanied by Susan Geringer, an India travel and tour specialist, and Yatish Bahuguna, a well-known Indian wildlife guide and naturalist, guests will also visit the cities of Delhi, Jaipur and Agra. The 14-day tour, priced from \$3,999 per person, double, is scheduled to depart the U.S. on Saturday, March 10, 2012.

Guests will become acquainted with India's diverse ecology, including dense vegetation and forests with rare medicinal plants and exotic flowers, prolific bird life with myriad varieties unique to the region and abundant wildlife. During the trip, guests will visit Ranthambhore National Park, one of India's Project Tiger reserves and largest national parks. Conservation programs and successful breeding programs have saved many species from near extinction. Situated in Sawai Madhopur, Ranthambhore is home to one of the largest banyan trees in India and one of the best places for guests to spot the majestic predators of the jungle.

Guests will experience an elephant ride and game drives exploring the rocky terrain of Bandhavgarh National Park, where the famous white tigers of Rewa were discovered, and home of the largest known tiger population in India. Guests will then head to one of the most well maintained parks in Asia, Kanha National Park. Kanha National Park, a tiger reserve with lush bamboo forests, grassy meadows and ravines, provided inspiration for Rudyard Kipling's famous novel, "The Jungle Book." In addition to the diverse wildlife and bird population at Kanha Wildlife Sanctuary, the highlight of the park is Bamni Dadar, popularly known as Sunset Point, which offers an awe-inspiring backdrop of the sunset.

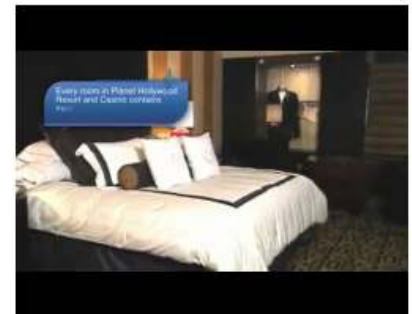
