**8-Day Golden Week in Venice:** Scheduled Sept. 30-Oct. 7, 2018, this program starts at \$4,990 per person double. From the group's base in a Grand Canal Palazzo, they experience the beauty of Venice while being guided through the architecture of the Piazza San Marco and exploring La Fenice Opera House and the Peggy Guggenheim Collection. They spend a day visiting Burano, the island of lace-makers, immerse themselves in Venice's Rialto market, cook with a local signora and paint their very own Venetian mask in a traditional artisan workshop.

**9-Day Golden Week in Southern Italy and Amalfi Coast:** Set for Oct. 13-21, 2018, this program starts at \$3,999 per person double. From their your base in the town of Sorrento, they discover the marvels of Capri, Naples, the ancient ruins of Pompeii, the thermal springs of Ischia and the Amalfi Coast. They shop for artisan treasures, sip local wines and enjoy world-famous cuisine. Pricing does not include international airfare, travel insurance, gratuities and optional activities and meals that are not designated in the itinerary.
