Florence is one of the stops on Perillo Tours' 10-day Vesuvius Tour, which features off-season discounts for nine departures from Oct. 28 to April 13.

Perillo Tours has off-season discounts for its 10-day guided Vesuvius Tour, visiting Rome, Florence, Naples, Pompeii, Capri, Sorrento and Venice with prices ranging from \$2,890 U.S. to \$3,390 per person. There are nine departures from Oct. 28 to April 13. Airfare, which is extra, can be arranged from several U.S. cities, including Newark, N.J., New York City (JFK) and Boston.

The itinerary begins in Rome with a three-night stay at the four-star NH Vittorio Veneto hotel, between Villa Borghese and Via Veneto. Guests take a tour of Imperial Rome and visit St. Peter's Basilica, the Colosseum and the Vatican Museums.

En route to Sorrento, you stop in Naples and Pompeii. In Naples, guests arrive via Vomero Hill overlooking the sapphire Bay of Naples, Capri, Ischia and Vesuvius and explore Castel dell'Ovo, San Carlo Opera House, Santa Lucia, Town Hall and the Angevin Castle.

In Pompeii, see one of Italy's best-known archaeological sites preserved by the ash of Mount Vesuvius. Then it's dinner and a two-night stay at the deluxe Parco Dei Principi, a hotel set on a cliff overlooking the bay of Naples in the heart of Sorrento.
