### Quebec, Canada

While everyone else tries to flee the final weeks of winter, some love the cold. For those families, the lakeside [Manoir Hovey](#) hotel in the Eastern Townships of Quebec offers an upscale take on the region's traditional sugar shacks—dating from the 1800s, the shacks were places where the men who worked in the woods tapping maple trees at the start of the spring thaw would gather for big, hearty meals. Here, it takes the form of Sunday lunches (through April 15) with birch syrup donuts and maple-smoked game sausages served family-style, with the traditional dessert of sugar on snow served outside and a warm digestif of Ungava gin and birch syrup reduction for the parents.
