Pompeii, Herculaneum & Classical Campania is the latest itinerary from archaeological touring experts [Andante Travels](#). The eight-day journey showcases the [UNESCO](#) World Heritage sites of Pompeii and Herculaneum in the company of professional guides and lecturers who have experience working at these historic locations.

The tour includes a whole day at Pompeii exploring forums, theaters, bathing structures and villas recently made accessible to the public; the temples at Paestum; the National Archaeological Museum at Naples; access to the massive Piscina Mirabilis at Misenum; the ruins at Herculaneum; the preserved villa of Oplontis and an ascent to the crater at Vesuvius; and a visit to the once-exclusive Roman resorts at Villa San Marco and Villa Arianna of Stabiae.

Upcoming departure dates include September, October and November. Prices begin at \$2,765 per person, based on double occupancy and excluding international airfare.

What's included: all meals with wine at dinner, excluding lunch at Pompeii; hotel accommodations; expert guides; a tour manager; transportation in an air-conditioned coach; entry tickets and tips; plus field notes.
