

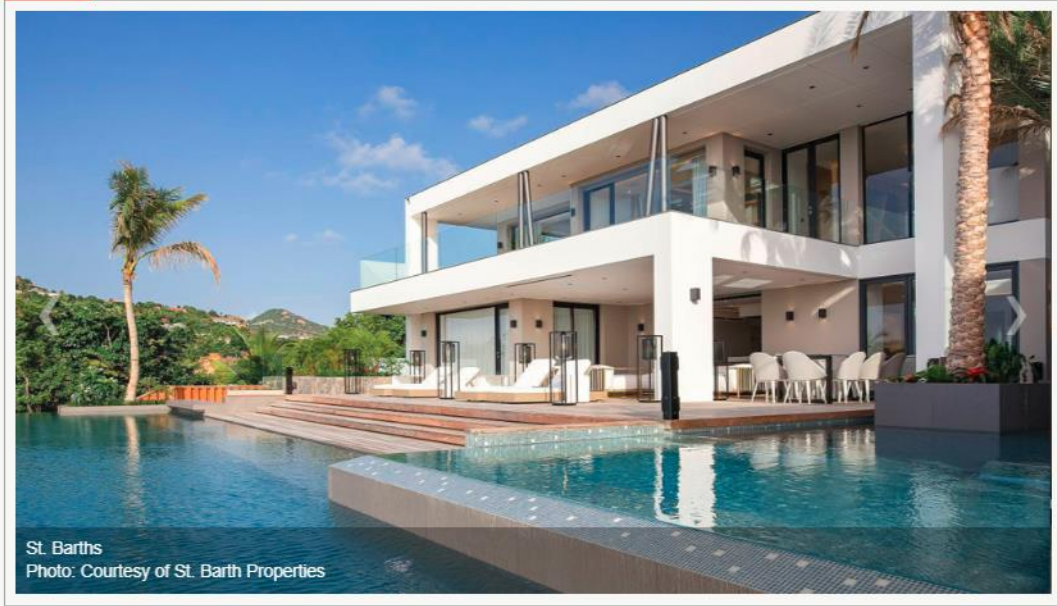

As the [Caribbean returns after last year’s hurricanes](#), St. Barths’s numerous ultra-luxe homes have everything you could ever need to truly relax. The recently built [Villa Neo](#) is part of St. Barth Properties’ Grand Cru Collection, and boasts one of the island’s largest heated pools, a fitness room, hammam, media room, and night club—you know, for when baby finally dozes off.
