Fly-Fishing the Caribbean

Thirty-five miles off the coast of Belize, the Turneffe Island Resort is one special Caribbean getaway, especially if you love to fish. You and Dad can spend the day fishing the flats surrounding the island for bonefish, tarpon, or permit with world-class fly-fishing guides to help him land a trophy fish. If diving is more his passion, the resort is only a 90-minute boat ride away from the famous Great Blue Hole, routinely ranking as one of the top-ten dive sites in the world. Surf the Swell

Huntington Beach is one of the iconic beaches of the California coastline. The sand goes on forever, the weather seems to always be perfect, and best of all it has one of the most consistent surf breaks in the country. The U.S. Open of Surfing will be taking place there this summer, but you don't have to be a pro to paddle out — there are numerous breaks that any level of surfer can surf. The Paséa Hotel & Spa is located on the beach and offers a Surf Butler. Roping and Riding

Mountain Bike the Grand Canyon

For four days, you and Dad can ride single-track through some of the most remote country in the continental United States. Each day riders on this trip wind through intermediate trails as they trace the outside boundary of the Northern Rim of Grand Canyon National Park (biking is not allowed inside its borders). The 72 miles that are covered in the trip are all above 8,000 feet, so riders are spared the brutal heat of the desert landscape.
