Follow in the Footsteps of Martin Luther with Zicasso

From visiting the church where Martin Luther posted his 95 Theses to spending the night in the 1,000-year-old Wartburg Castle, travelers can follow in the footsteps of the great reformer from Berlin to Munich on **Zicasso's** 10-day custom tailored itinerary through Germany.

Just in time for the 500th anniversary of the Protestant Reformation this year, Zicasso has introduced an *In the Footsteps of Martin Luther: 500-Year Anniversary of Protestant Reformation* itinerary. On the tour, travelers will have the opportunity to stand in the doorway of Schlosskirche where Martin Luther posted his 95 Theses; tour Lutherhaus, the home

where Martin Luther spent most of his adult life and wrote his 95 Theses; and spend a night in Wartburg Castle, a UNESCO World Heritage Site where Martin Luther hid in exile and translated the Bible from Latin into German. In addition, the tour includes a trip to the city of Erfurt, where guests will find the Augustinian Monastery where Luther became a monk.

Rates start at \$3,249 pp dbl and include accommodations in four- and five-star hotels including breakfasts, all airport transfers, a *First Class* train ticket from Berlin to Wittenberg, five privately-guided tours in Berlin, Wittenberg and Munich; *The Night Watchman Tour* of Rothenburg, a Mercedes E-Class (or similar vehicle of the same class) rental car from Wittenberg to Munich (including full insurance and unlimited mileage), and 24/7 travel concierge services.
