November 26: Frontier Airlines is running a Cyber Monday fare sale, with one-way fares from \$36 (including taxes and government fees) to U.S. domestic destinations. **Tickets must be purchased by 11:59 ET on Thursday, November 29, 2012** and can be purchased at www.FlyFrontier.com. The fares are one-way (a round-trip purchase is not required), for travel between **January 7 and March 6, 2013 from Mondays through Thursdays and on Saturdays**. Higher sale fares apply to travel on Fridays and Sundays. A 21-day advance purchase is required. Blackout dates of February 14, February 15 and February 18 apply. Sample sale fares from Frontier's Denver hub include Phoenix-Mesa, \$36; Albuquerque, \$49; Colorado Springs, \$49; Durango, \$49; Kansas City, \$59; and Oklahoma City, \$59. Sample fares from Colorado Springs include Los Angeles, \$59; Phoenix, \$69; and Orlando, \$99.

November 26: Virgin America has launched a fare sale with one-way Main Cabin fares starting from \$77. **Fare sale tickets must be purchased by 11:59 p.m. CST on December 3, 2012. On November 26 only, guests can also take an additional 10 per cent off the airline's fares** by booking at www.virginamerica.com using the code CYBER10. Tickets are on sale at www.virginamerica.com and at 1.877.FLY.VIRGIN. Main Cabin fares for routes LAX-SFO, LAS-SFO, SAN-SFO, PSP-SFO, SEA-LAX, SEA-SFO, LAX-PDX, PDX-SFO, SEA-LAS, SEA-SAN, PDX-LAS, and PDX-SAN require a 10-day advance purchase and travel must occur between December 7, 2012 and March 6, 2013. Main Cabin fares for routes BOS-LAX, BOS-SFO, JFK-LAX, JFK-LAS, JFK-SFO, DCA-SFO, BOS-SAN, BOS-LAS, BOS-SEA, BOS-PDX, BOS-PSP, JFK-SAN, JFK-SEA, and JFK-PDX require a 21-day advance purchase and travel must occur between December 19, 2012 and March 6, 2013. Main Cabin fares for JFK-PSP require a 21-day advance purchase and travel must occur between December 29, 2012 and March 6, 2013. All other Main Cabin fares require a 14-day advance purchase and travel must occur between December 12, 2012 and March 6, 2013. The lowest sale fares are available only on certain itineraries. The lowest sale fares for routes LAX-SFO, LAS-SFO, SAN-SFO, PSP-SFO, SEA-LAX, SEA-SFO, LAX-PDX, PDX-SFO, SEA-LAS, SEA-SAN, PDX-LAS, and PDX-SAN are not valid for travel on Sundays. The lowest sale fares for JFK-PSP are valid only for non-stop travel on Saturdays. 2012 blackout dates are December 21, December 22, December 23, December 26 and December 30. 2013 blackout dates are January 1, January 2, January 5, January 6, January 18, January 21, February 15 and February 18.

November 26: Alaska Airlines has launched a fare sale for travel after the holidays. One-way sale fares start at \$49 from Reno to San Jose (California), \$59 from Seattle to San Francisco and \$159 from Oakland to Maui and there are many other sale fares at the same or similar prices. **Tickets must be purchased by December 3 for travel between January 8 and March 6, 2013.** However, travel on sale fares ends on February 11 to Hawaii from markets outside of California and on February 21 to La Paz, Mexico. Fares require a 14-day advance purchase, except for travel to and from Mexico and Hawaii, for which there is no advance purchase. 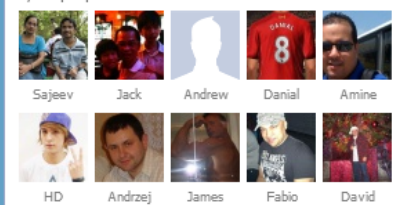

November 26: Finnair is offering limited-time special fares from New York to Europe. Customers **booking by December 11** can fly Economy Class to 14 destinations, including Moscow, Berlin, Riga, and Stockholm and many more European cities, starting from \$609 round-trip, including taxes and fees. Customers can also book round-trip Business Class travel on Finnair to selected destinations such as Moscow, Rovaniemi, St. Petersburg and Warsaw from \$1,499 (to Moscow) or \$1,999 (to other major cities in Northern Europe) including taxes and fees. **Travel must be completed by March 20, 2013.** Children between 2 and 11 years old traveling with an adult can be booked for 25 per cent off the adult fare price before taxes; and infants under 2 years traveling without their own seat can be booked for 90 per cent off the adult fare price before taxes. These fares do not apply to bookings for unaccompanied minors. Stopovers are not permitted. Changes are permitted before and after departure for an additional fee of \$250. Tickets are non-refundable. September 25: Members of the American Airlines AAdvantage program who travel round-trip between the United States or Canada and Europe can **earn AAdvantage bonus miles through January 31, 2013** for travel on First Class, Business Class or select Economy Class fares. American's joint business relationship with British Airways and Iberia also allows members to earn bonus miles **when flying on any of the three carriers** during the promotion. For the first round-trip, members earn 15,000 bonus miles. After three round trips, members will earn a total of 100,000 bonus miles. For the second, they earn 35,000 bonus miles and for the third, 50,000 bonus miles. Each additional round trip provides members with another 50,000 bonus miles. There is no limit to the number of bonus miles that can be earned during the promotion. AAdvantage members can participate in the bonus miles offer by registering prior to travel at www.AA.com/Offers using promotion code AAEUR.

August 14: Finnair is offering a **15 per cent discount on Business Class adult round-trip fares** to selected destinations in Europe and Asia for **American Express cardholders, for travel by December 31, 2013.** Destinations covered in the promotion, via Finnair's northern route through Helsinki-Vantaa Airport, include Bangkok, Budapest, Moscow, Paris, St. Petersburg, Singapore and Warsaw. These fares require the use of flight numbers AY006 and AY005 from and to New York JFK. **Additionally, Finnair Plus members can now upgrade to Finnair Plus Silver-tier membership when taking return Business Class flights by December 31, 2013.** Silver tier, part of the Finnair Plus frequent-flyer program, offers amenities such as Business Class check-in, 10 per cent off at Finnair Tax-Free shops, extra baggage allocation and access to Finnair Lounge services. June 2: The southern office of **Vietnam Airlines has launched a program of steep promotional discounts for passengers buying tickets one or two months in advance for return tickets from Ho Chi Minh City to Bangkok, Kuala Lumpur or Singapore. The promotion runs until December 31.** Return tickets from Ho Chi Minh City to Kuala Lumpur are being priced at 399,000 Vnd (US\$19) for passengers **booking two months in advance** and 1.26 million Vnd (US\$60) for passengers **booking one month in advance** for round-trip flights from Ho Chi Minh City to Singapore, Kuala Lumpur and Bangkok. Vietnam Airlines says the advance-booking discount program will allow it to control and exploit its seat inventory on the routes more effectively, reducing unnecessary costs and providing passengers with services at a reasonable price. **Vietnam Airlines also has a promotion offering a 37 per cent discount on its regular business-class fares from Ho Chi Minh City to Bangkok, Singapore and Kuala Lumpur.** Round-trip business class fares for the carrier's Ho Chi Minh City-Singapore and Ho Chi Minh-Kuala Lumpur services now cost 8.4 million Vnd (US\$399) and 6.3 million Vnd (US\$299) for its Ho Chi Minh City-Bangkok flights. **These prices apply for departures up until December 31.** For more information, visit www.vietnam-airline.org.
