FINNAIR OPENS DIRECT SUMMER ROUTE FROM TORONTO TO EUROPE

More than 50 destinations available via Helsinki with Finnair's new direct route from Toronto



Finnair will reintroduce a direct summer route between Toronto and Helsinki with connections to more than 50 destinations in Europe. Finnair will offer a scheduled flight between Toronto Pearson International Airport and Helsinki Airport five days a week from May 26 to Sept. 11, 2011, with summer rates starting at \$825.

Finnair will also open two new destinations including Murmansk in Northern Russia and Aarhus in Denmark in cooperation with

Sun-Air.

Leisure flights to Malaga and Nice will change to a scheduled service during the summer session.

Direct services to other familiar summer destinations include Slovenia, Poland, Lisbon and Pisa.

In addition to serving over 50 destinations in Europe, Finnair flies to 10 cities in Asia via Helsinki such as Delhi, Hong Kong or Seoul. Flights to Delhi start at \$999.

A direct service between Chicago and Helsinki will begin May 14, 2011, when oneworld partner American Airlines starts operating the new route.
