Nine Places To Touch The Bases...

Baseball Greats

Why not take some personal time out and give the kids a crash program in baseball history on your next family vacation. Here are 9 places with winning innings for adults and children.

■ **Baltimore (MD).** The row house where Babe Ruth grew up is now a museum devoted to The Bambino (216 Emory St, 3 blocks west of Oriole Park at Camden Yards ☎ 410-727-1539, www.baberuthmuseum.com). Then walk to the nearby Sports Legends Museum (301 W Camden St in the Camden Station building, next to Oriole Park and the B&O Warehouse). It's filled with exhibits on the history of the Orioles, of amateur and minor league baseball in Maryland and more.

■ **Birmingham (AL).** The oldest stadium in the country, Rickwood Field (1137 Second Ave W ☎ 800-RICK-WOOD, www.rickwood.com) was built in 1910 at a cost of \$75,000. Among the legends who played here: Willie Mays, Babe Ruth, Ty Cobb and Shoeless Joe Jackson. Scenes from the 1994 movie *Cobb* and the 1995 *Soul of the Game* were filmed here. Currently being restored, there are plans to open a Museum of Southern Baseball in the future.

■ **Cooperstown (NY).** At the National Baseball Hall of Fame & Museum (25 Main St ☎ 888-425-5633, www.baseballhalloffame.org) you can learn about the 295 inductees, starting in 1936 with Ty Cobb, Walter Johnson, Babe Ruth and Honus Wagner. The museum has the largest library on the history of baseball — some 2.6 million items.

CIVIL WAR: ANNIVERSARY #150

Nancy Dunnan recommends the Mason Inn & Conference Center in Fairfax (VA) for families and history buffs visiting nearby historic sites. Its Civil War Anniversary Package starts at just \$109/night and incl bkfst for 2 and 2 packed lunches.

The 148-room Inn, which has an on-site fitness center, is on Mason Pond Drive, steps from George Mason University. There's free parking and a free shuttle around the campus and to/from the Vienna Metro stop. The dining room serves B, L & D daily. ☎ 877-296-6695, 703-865-5705, www.acc-masoninnandconferencecenter.com. Thru Oct 31.

(Note: \$5 from each booked package will be donated to the Civil War Trust (www.civilwar.org)).

The Inn is also approx 20 mi from Manassas National Battlefield Park (www.nps.gov/mana/index.htm). This summer/fall, the Park is offering lectures, period music, parades, reenactments, dances and more.

Last month, riding the Chiltern Railway (www.chilternrailways.co.uk) out of London's Marylebone Station, we explored beautiful Buckinghamshire and two British Prime Ministers' homes — Hughenden Manor and Chequers. (Call ☎ 800-327-3633 for a free copy.) This month we continue northwest on the same line with The Englishman to visit two historic places — Leamington Spa and Warwick Castle.

GETTING THERE

By Bus: Full-day tours operated by Evan Evans (☎ 800-422-9022, www.evanevanstours.co.uk) leave from London's Victoria Coach Station (complimentary pick-up from many hotels) and visit Warwick Castle, Stratford-upon-Avon, the Cotswolds and Oxford; \$120/adult, \$105 ages 3-16, \$115/seniors 60+ and students. Incl admission to the Castle, Christ Church College and Shakespeare's birthplace. (The company has been in business since 1933.)

National Express (☎ 011-44-871-8178, www.nationalexpress.com) has service also from Victoria Coach Station to Warwick (approx 4 hours, with 1 transfer) for \$45 r/t or to Leamington Spa (approx 3 hours, direct) for \$35 r/t.

On the 9-night **Polar Bear Backpacker Program**, designed for students, backpackers and adventure lovers who wish to experience Canada's arctic region, you'll travel 4 nights by wilderness rail from Winnipeg to Churchill and the shores of Hudson Bay to see polar bears in their natural habitat. Incl r/t train fare, full-day tundra vehicle tour with an experienced naturalist, 3 nights' dorm accommodations at the **Winnipeg Downtowner**, 2 nights at the **Bear Country Inn** in Churchill. Every autumn, the bears gather along the Hudson Bay waters waiting for sea ice to form. Once the bay freezes over, they move onto the ice where they spend the winter hunting seal. You'll see the bears from a heated vehicle/buggy that seats 36 passengers, has a bathroom and an outside viewing platform. Its 6-foot diameter tires allow access onto the tundra.

Note: A shorter 5-night program with air between Winnipeg and Churchill is priced at \$1,945.

With the price of gasoline skyrocketing, many Americans are thinking twice about driving, especially non-required driving.

So, before you jump into a car, head for www.CostToDrive.com. Here you'll find the answer to that key question: How much will it cost to drive from Point A to Point B?

The founders of **CostToDrive.com** designed and built the unique and easy-to-use "calculator" tool to determine just that. Simply enter where you're starting out (address, city or ZIP code), where you're going and what car you will be driving (year, make and model). The oldest car for which information is available is 1990.

TIP: You can also check the most popular drives by state. Find out, for instance the driving time and cost between Portland (OR) and Denver (CO); then compare it with flying.

Fun Facts: ■ It costs \$609 to drive from NY to Los Angeles in a Hummer H3. ■ Only \$229 with a Toyota Prius. ■ It costs \$8.39, with a carbon footprint of 53.3 lbs to drive an Acura TL from Tarrytown (NY) to Commack (NY), about 60 miles. ■ In a Honda Insight, it's about \$4.78 with a carbon footprint of 32.2 lbs. ■ The Honda uses only 1.3 gallons of gas. ■ The Acura uses 2.2 gallons.
